Colonoscopy Preparation

Checklist

Follow the instructions for colonoscopy prep with Miralax/Gatorade, Golytely or Vesicol/Osmo from the prep sheets.

- If you take a blood thinner like Aspirin, Coumadin or Plavix, please let us know.
- Stop Coumadin 5 days, Aspirin and Plavix 7 days prior to your procedure after checking with your family physician/cardiologist.
- Check with Dr. Yakhmi/Our office before restarting these medications.
- Do not take insulin or anti-diabetes medications the morning of your colonoscopy. Let your doctor know about your medications.
- Bring your medications with you on the day of the procedure so that you can take them after the procedure.
- Let the doctor know if you could be pregnant. This procedure could be unsafe for pregnant women
- Stop iron tablets 5 days prior to colonoscopy.
- Do not eat or drink after midnight the night before the test (except for the prep).
- Arrive at least one (1) hour before your scheduled time to allow for pre-procedure preparations.
- You must have someone drive you home after the procedure (spouse, parent, child, relative, or friend). You cannot take a cab, bus, limo, bike, or walk.
